½ minute sit stay & 1 minute down stay on lead.

Heelwork on lead and heel free

Recall off lead

1 minute sit stay & 2 minute down stay

Heelwork on lead and heel free

Recall with a finish

Retrieve dumbbell

1 minute sit stay & 2 minute down stay

Top Notch

Heelwork on lead and heel free with change of pace

Send away

Retrieve dumbbell with finish

1 minute sit stay & 2 minute down stay

Judge: June Clayton

Rosettes to 6th place in all classes and a plaque for 1st place
